Currently we have 715 Students from Balvatika to class 10 on roll. The strength of the staff stands at 51 which includes 38 teaching and 13 non-teaching.

Proud to state that out of 59 Students 40 Secured distinction, 17 First classes and 02 Second classes. Also 2 secured Centum (100 out of 100) in Kannada subject.

Our students are known for balancing academics and non-academics activities. Regular tests and exams keep our students academically updated. Open houses create a cordial relationship between parents and teachers which helps in improving the performance of students.

I am happy to state that, the overall performance of students in academics in every section of classes is outstanding year by year.

Free coaching after school for those who require is a facility provided by the school. Sports is highly active at our school. Children stay back after school hours and get trained in the choice of their sport by qualified and experienced coaches. The school has a strong athletic, basketball and football teams as of now. We are building up the cricket team too. The management being sport lovers have provided all the facilities to students. Free coaching, bus facility and breakfast for those who come at 7.00am is something we experience only at Nitte and we are blessed to be a part of it.

The school library has stacked 13,365 books. Reading habit and love for books needs to be encouraged in our children. With this intention in mind, we issue books to students of classes 5 to 10 every day.

Our ATL Lab is in the 5th year and working well. Our students are very curious to tinker and it has led to creativity and imagination. Every year the synopsis of our students get selected for the INSPIRE awards. We have even represented National level.

Scouts and Guides team is active and has quite a lot of activities.

Our school is a member of Red Cross Society promoting Solidarity, National and International friendship.

School encourages students to think out of box by answering higher order questions in various external exams such as Science Olympiad, spell bee, Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan etc. They have entered the national level too in all these exams by getting through different levels.

To teach our children the joy of caring and sharing, we observe Rose week. The contribution in kind or cash is given to the deserving by our school cabinet.

Our school band is the centre of attraction for all events and programmes held at various institutions of Nitte.

We have a classroom connect with “Hutchesons Grammar School” of Scotland. 2 students and 1 teacher get a sponsored visit to Scotland and 10 to 15 members visit us from Scotland every year. From the time of pandemic, it has come to pause and we have been assured of reestablishing our connect.
