The Torch - Bearers of our Institution

JUSTICE K. S. HEGDE
(1909 to 1990)

Kawdoor Sadananda Hegde (June 16, 1909 - May 25, 1990) is a former Speaker of the Lok Sabha, a Supreme Court Judge, and the founder of the Nitte Education Trust. He is the father of Santhosh Hegde, who was also a Judge of the Supreme Court of India.

He served as a public prosecutor from 1947-51. In 1952, he was elected to the Rajya Sabha, a position which he held until 1957. In 1967, Hegde was appointed a Judge in the Supreme Court of India. On 30 April 1973, Hegde tendered his resignation, as a matter of principle, when one of his junior colleagues was appointed as the Chief Justice of India.

Thereafter, Hegde once again started taking an active part in socio-political movements. In 1977, he was elected to the Lok Sabha from the Bangalore South constituency on a Janata Party ticket. Hegde was elected from Bangalore to the Lok Sabha in 1977. Several months later, he became Speaker after the resignation of his predecessor, Neelam Sanjiva Reddy. He held the position from 1977 to 1980. He also established the Nitte Education Trust in 1979 to provide a high school to the village of Nitte. Hegde died in on May 24, 1990 in Karnataka. [1]

As a judge of the Supreme Court of India, his lordship was also a part of the thirteen judge bench which decided the famous Kesavananda Bharati V., State of Kerala. However, he resigned soon after delivering the majority judge, as Justice A. N. Ray was appointed the Chief Justice of India, although Hegde was senior judge at the time.

The K. S. Hegde Medical Academy, a medical college in Deralakatte and a unit of the Nitte Education Trust, was named after Hegde. The Justice KS Hegde Charitable Foundation, a trust dedicated to advancement of education and community development in Mangalore, was established in memory of Hegde.

DR. NITTE SHANKARA ADYANTHAYA (1905 to 1962)



Dr. Nitte Shankara Adyanthaya is the second son of Sri. Siddhu Shetty and Nitte Rukmini Adyanthaya. He was born on 22nd September, 1905. Sri. Siddhu Shetty was an agriculturist and owned vast land. He was a very forward thinking man and had a dream of educating his four children- two boys and two girls. At a very tender age of 6 years, Shankara Adyanthaya lost his father. Fate was unkind to him once again when he lost his mother at the age of 12. Young Shankara attended the Karkala Board High School. Being a bright and hard working student, he had an ambition to become a doctor. Unfortunately, the death of both his parents had shattered his dreams. However, his maternal aunt Smt. Sesamma supported his education and helped him to join Stanley Medical College, Madras where he completed his MBBS. During his studies he developed the values of simplicity, compassion and discipline.

Soon after his studies at Madras he started medical practice initially for a short while at Udupi. Soon young Dr. Shankar Adyanthaya realised that his services were more required at Karkala. Thus he came to Karkala. Later he went to Calcutta to do a PG diploma in ophthalmology. He soon became a very popular doctor not only in the town but also in the neighbouring villages. Medical profession during the 1930s and 1940s was more of social service as there were not many hospitals and commuting was difficult because of the poor transport facilities. This did not deter Dr. Shankara Adyanthaya and he took up this task by making huge sacrifice of his personal life. He even had facilities attached to his clinic for patients on who he had operated for cataract. He was very methodical, punctual, disciplined, and humane in his approach in his work and profession. Many times he would give the patients money for travelling and would also give food grains to the poor during his home visits.

Always dressed in impeccable white, Dr. Shankara Adyanthaya was very particular about cleanliness and hygiene. He would always uphold 'dignity of labour' and would not hesitate to clean the litter in and around his clinic and house. He was a soft spoken and an affectionate doctor and was thus loved and respected by one and all. He had a special affection for patients from Nitte. In addition to serving his patients, Dr. Shankara Adyanthaya was very much interested in agriculture and animal husbandry and was a role model for Nitte village in both these areas. He was one of the first to introduce large scale cultivation of arecanut and coconut in the area.

Dr. Shankara Adyanthaya married Kumuda the eldest daughter of Sri Kowdoor Srinivas Hegde and Smt. Rathi Hegde and had six children. Their three daughters Vatsala, Vidya and Sujatha are married to men of stature respectively to Dr. N. R. Shetty, who was the Vice- Chancellor of Bangalore University, and Sri B. R. Hegde, an engineer and a Trustee of Nitte Education Trust and Sri N. Vinaya Hegde, the President of Nitte Education Trust, the Chancellor of Nitte University and the Chairman of Lamina group of companies. The three sons Sri Siddu Adyanthaya, was senior executive with Air-India, Sri Devdas Adyanthaya and Sri Jeevandas Adyanthaya are businessmen. Dr. Shankara Adyanthaya always wanted to start a high school in Nitte as he had a special affection for its people. This interest in rural education and the motivation of his sister Meenakshi Hegde, the wife of Justice K S Hegde, Founder of Nitte Education Trust, paved the way for starting schools and colleges to be named after him.

On 30th July, 1962 he suddenly passed away leaving behind a fine legacy of humanitarian values.

GENERAL INFORMATION

SCHOOL UNIFORM

The school uniform should be compulsorily worn on **all working days**. Wear clean washed **ironed Uniform** every day.

Boys : Maroon and cream checked, half sleeved shirt with a pocket on the left. Maroon SHORTS (LKG to Class VII) and Maroon PANTS with pockets on either sides (Classes VIII - XII), Tight Pants, low waist pants not permitted. Pants bottom must be 16" inches.

Girls : Maroon and cream checked short sleeved blouse with collar.
Maroon pinafore (LKG to VII)
Maroon skirt (Classes VIII to X)
(Both Boys and Girls should wear the School Belt and neck tie everyday except Wednesday.
White T-Shirt on every Wednesday KG to Class to V.
House T-Shirt on every Wednesday (Classes VI to X)

Foot Wear :

Black Canvas / Black Leather Shoes and maroon school socks. **Black Sandals / Black Rainy Shoes** without socks in the monsoons.

Girls : 2 Ponytails or 2 plaits

Boys : Short trimmed, simple, neat hair style.

SCHOOL FEES

1. Fees should be paid as per the mode selected **Annually / Installment**.
2. **The fee Challan must reach the school office on the same day or within a week of payment.**

TRANSPORTATION

1. Those opting for transportation facilities cannot enter or withdraw in between the Academic Year. **One way permission cannot be granted.**
2. Students are requested to keep to the Bus Timings and should wait at the left side of the Vehicle. Be there 5 mts prior to the scheduled time.

3. Students should use transport strictly as per the boarding and alighting points mentioned at time of payment.
4. The bus will run only to stops as mentioned and not to the individual houses.
5. No change in bus routes entertained in between the year.
6. One way payment is strictly not permitted.

SCHOOL MESS

1. The school provides simple, hot, vegetarian food on a meagre payment by choice.
2. No inclusions in between the academic year.

BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

- ✧ Students may distribute sweets to their classmates on their Birthdays, during intervals only, to avoid disturbance to essential class time. They are permitted to wear coloured dress on this occasion upto **grade 4** only.
- ✧ Parents are requested to contribute some fund on the Birthday of their children to enable the school to do charitable work on behalf of students, who must cultivate empathy and a sense of social service towards the under privileged at a young age.

NITTE - HUTCHIE CLASSROOM CONNECT

- ✧ Our school has won the International School Award ISA (2006-09) of the British Council.
- ✧ The school also received grants from the British Aid towards Global School Partnership for 4 years from 2007 to 2010. Twelve teachers and 22 students were privileged to visit Scotland for a week each, during this period of 8 years.
- ✧ 22 teachers and 37 pupils from Scotland have visited us at NITTE.
- ✧ We receive grants for **Connecting Classrooms** of the British Council. This program supports teachers to learn new tools and develop skills for helping young people prepare for life and work in a globalised world and supports the Annual visit of 2 students & 1 teacher.

- ✧ This program of Connecting Classrooms is genuinely interested in making young people's learning richer, more varied contemporary and exciting. It also supports teacher exchange visits.
- ✧ The Hutchie school annually encourages pupils to work on, Nitte Hutchie Project - the topic for which is one of the 20 Millennium Goals. The winning pair gets a reward to visit Scotland for a week.

LIBRARY & LAB RULES

1. Students from Classes 5-10 are encouraged to borrow books at a time, with entry in their school diary.
2. Books must be handled with utmost care. Writing or marking on any book is strictly forbidden.
3. Borrowed books must be either returned or renewed on the due date.
4. If books are lost, it must be replaced by a similar title or a fine must be paid.
5. Fine will be levied if books are not returned on the due date and in good condition.
6. Students of Class X will be permitted to borrow 2 to 3 reference books at a time for a maximum period of 15 days. After the Board Exams, Library Books must be returned the very next day.
7. We request parents to encourage their children to develop general reading habits.
8. During practical's in the laboratory, instructions given by the teachers and safety measures must be strictly adhered to.
9. Damage/breakage of apparatus must be made good by students.
10. Encourage children to cultivate good reading habits.

ATTENDANCE

1. Regular and punctual attendance is required. A minimum of 80% attendance is considered for promotion.
2. However when pupils are absent especially on account of illness parents are expected to write a brief leave note in the "**ABSENT COLUMN**" of the diary. Sickness of three days or more should be supported by a doctor's certificate.

3. **Attendance on re-opening and closing days is mandatory.** Written permission must be sought if attendance is impossible on these days.
4. Absence without permission/information is not acceptable and calls for strict action.
5. **Long leave of absence is not given unless asked for in writing and sanctioned by the Principal.**
6. A child with **contagious or infectious disease should not be sent to school till he/she fully recovers.** Doctor's certificate is a must.
7. Ensure the student attends all School Functions / Activities.

SCHOOL DISCIPLINE POLICY

1. Pupils must be in the school premises 10 minutes before the school begins. Late comers must write a note of excuse in the diary and get the class teacher's signature.
2. **Fresh, neat and ironed** uniform must be worn everyday. Trendy hair styles are forbidden.
3. Students are not permitted to leave the school vicinity during school hours without the prior permission of the Principal.
4. **Wearing of gold chains strictly not allowed.**
5. Students must take responsibility of their personal belongings. We take no responsibility for loss of gold ornaments or anything expensive.
6. The school is not responsible for articles or money lost.
7. Running, playing, shouting and whistling inside the school building is strictly prohibited.
8. Scribbling on walls or furniture or damaging any school property is an offence for which fine can be levied.
9. **Mobiles, CD's, Gizmos, I-pods, Video Games will be confiscated if brought to school and returned only to parents.**
10. English must be compulsorily spoken in the School Campus. **Vernacular conversations and use of abusive and foul language is strictly forbidden** and if caught invites disciplinary action.
11. Malpractice during Assessments is strictly prohibited.

12. **Students will not be permitted to leave the school in between the class hours for any reason.**

13. Wrist watches are permitted from class 7.

14. Every pupil should endeavour to keep up the high standard of the school, by excelling in academics and good manners.

GOVERNMENT OF INDIA – PROJECTS

Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) Govt. of India through National Testing Agency has selected our school as a Test Practice Centre for all competitive entrance exams, that come under National Testing Agency such as JEE, CAT, MAT etc.

Our school has been selected by the Government of India for setting up the ATL. ₹ 12 lakhs for setting up the lab and in 4 years ₹ 8 lakhs will be funded by the Government of India. This Atal Tinkering lab was inaugurated on 22nd June 2018, by Sri N. Vinaya Hegde, Chancellor of Nitte Deemed to be University and the President of the Nitte Education Trust.

INSTRUCTIONS TO PARENTS AND STUDENTS

Parents are requested to ensure the following :

1. Identification mark be put on belts, ties, socks, water bottles, Umbrellas etc.
2. They co-operate with the school authorities in matters of discipline, regular hours of study at home and punctual and regular attendance at school.
3. **They do not enter the classrooms, corridors or passage areas and see teachers/students during school hours or to reach/receive their ward in the class.**

9. Furnish Medical Certificate to the Principal along with leave application for long absence due to illness.
10. Any money sent to school, must be sent in sealed envelopes with student's name, class, amount and purpose.
11. **Parents can meet teachers between 3.30 p.m. to 4.30 p.m. from Monday to Friday.**
12. **Parents and students are discouraged strongly from giving or exchanging any kind of personal gifts to the Principal, teachers and members of the staff or friends in the school. However gifts to the School for student's benefit can be accepted.**
13. Encourage students to be **regular in attendance.**
14. **Speak well of the school and staff in the presence of your child and society.**
15. Use your calendar daily to take down the work assigned for next day.
16. Revise at the end of the week.
The school management reserves the right to add, alter or amend any of these rules.
